

REPORT OF THE TREE WARDEN

Sixty-seven trees were cut and removed from public ways, due to them being hazardous or damaged, to the point they could not be saved. Several trees that were blocking streets were removed. This was accomplished with the cooperation of the Monson Highway Department personnel and equipment. Tree stumps were ground and removed from tree belts on various streets, with those areas loamed and seeded. Maintenance and trimming of healthy trees continued as usual.

MICROBURST

On October 9, 2015 we experienced a microburst storm with damage to multiple trees on a section of Silver Street and Thayer Road. Highway Department personnel worked several hours, with their equipment, to re-open those roads, with several poles and powerlines down. First clean-up of debris was completed on October 15, 2015. We were also assisted by private contractors, with debris clean-up.
