ARTICLE 31 – PARKING BAN

The Board of Selectmen or its designee may declare a parking ban on all ways within the Town for the purpose of snow and ice removal or any other state of emergency and shall be responsible for lifting the ban when determined that it is no longer necessary.

Snow/Ice Removal:

In the event of a parking ban declaration for snow and ice removal, no motor vehicle, other than a Town vehicle acting in an emergency shall be parked on any way within the Town.

Between the hours of 6AM-1AM, parking will be permitted on Main Street between Hampden Avenue and Washington Street. Any legally operating business outside of this area that requires on-street parking during a ban shall contact the Police Department for permission, which shall be granted unless substantial public safety is a risk.

State of Emergency:

In the event of a parking ban declaration for a State of Emergency, no motor vehicle, other than one acting in an emergency, shall be parked on any way within the Town.

Motor Vehicle Removal:

The Chief of Police and/or the Highway Department Superintendent or their designee may remove or cause to be removed any motor vehicle parked in violation of the parking ban.

Owner Responsible for Charges:

The owner or operator of a motor vehicle removed pursuant to this bylaw shall be fully responsible for all charges and expenses incurred for removal and storage of such motor vehicle as well as the payment of any fines imposed under this bylaw.

Penalty for Violation of the Bylaw:

In addition to any other legal remedies that may be available, whoever violates any provision of this bylaw, the violation of which is subject to specific penalty, may be penalized by: non-criminal disposition as provided in Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 40, Section 21D as amended in accordance with the penalty and fine schedule established in the Town of Monson Bylaw; or take any other action relative thereto.
